

MINOR IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE

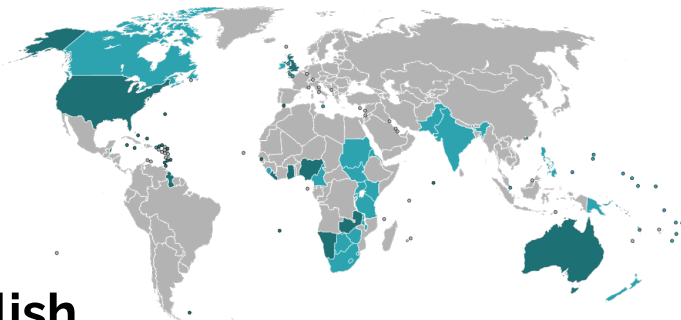
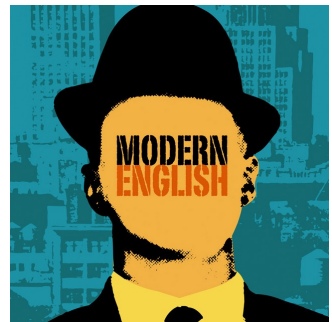
